The course is intended as a sound introduction to study the relevant research methods with an objective of understanding the difference between relevant qualitative and quantitative research by providing appropriate tools and techniques for problem identitification and solving as well as designing a successful research project.

Ismeretanyag:

- 1. The main characteristics of paradigms and research methods in public governance and public administration, similarities and differences compared to other branches of social sciences. Transcending the narrow scope of disciplinary views: the emergence of transdisciplinary research.
- 2. Methods of historical and comparative research, perspectives (model building tools, global, regional, multi-lateral, bilateral approaches) and constraints (historical institutionalism, path-dependency, need for techniques for critical analysis).
- 3. Empirical methods of research: case-study method, survey method, content analysis.
- 4. Methods of data collection primary sources, methods of making questionnaire and interview. Collecting secondary sources of data collection by using library and internet.
- 5. The concept (good state and governance) and measurability of state capacity, government ability and effective public administration. Actors (international, national) and their methods in measuring governmental performance, assessing their relative strengths and weaknesses.

Kompetencia:

At the end of the course, students will be able to apply the key methods (historical, comparative, empirical, qualitative and quantitative) in public governance and public administration by putting them into practice separately and/or in a combined form taking the transdisciplinary approach into account. They explore how is evidence used in identifying problems and developing solutions and possible alternatives in the making of governance and public administration. The students will have the necessary competencies for developing appropriate criteria for evaluating policy evidence as well as selecting and analysing "best practices". Last but not least, the students will develop their core skills including analytic thinking and creative problem solving which contribute for designing as well as delivering their research projects.
