Board of Governors

Terms of Reference:

The powers and duties of the Board of Governors are laid down under Act CXXXII of 2011 (NUPS Act) and the University's Organizational and Operational Regulations. It is for the Board of Governors to ensure that the activities of the University comply with the pertaining legislation and are aligned to the needs and requirements of the sector. During the performance of its duties, the Board of Governors shall fully respect the autonomy of the University in conducting its research and teaching. Subject to the provisions of the NUPS Act and the Organizational and Operational Regulations, the Board of Governors shall:

- ascertain the number of personnel assigned to higher positions at the University;
- ascertain the maximum number of students that can be admitted to each faculty;
- oversee the efficacy and lawfulness of the use of assets provided by the Hungarian Government;
- exercise legal supervision over the activities of the University;
- exercise its rights to internally monitor the use of state subsidy given to the University;
- ratify the University's Institutional Development Plan submitted to it by the Senate;
- submits the University's annual budgetary statement to the Government;
- during the planning of the annual central budget, submit the University's development plan to the Government;
- determine the University's system of professional control;
- ratify the University's regulations on qualified data protection;
- issue the invitation to tender for the position of the Rector.

Composition of the Board of Governors:

Pursuant to the provisions of the NUPS Act, the members of the Board of Governors are delegated by the Minister of Justice, the Minister of Defence, the Minister of Interior and the Minister responsible for development in public administration.
