for “INTERNATIONAL CHAIR” visiting professor position

In accordance with Rectoral Decree Nr. 13/2014 the International Chair position at the National University of Public Service (NUPS), the Rector of NUPS invites applications of candidates for the title International Chair. This fellowship will be offered to professors who wish to spend two semesters at NUPS conducting original research and teach courses.

I. Mission of the International Chair:

In order to foster internationalisation in education and research, the National University of Public Service would like to provide the appropriate mandate for international lecturers and researchers who are strongly committed to and capable of contributing to the expansion of the University’s academic and scientific achievements and international relations. His/ Her tasks include the involvement in the development of the University’s educational, research and teaching activities as well as in the academic organizing activities. As an internationally renowned expert within the branch of science in which he/ she gives lectures and conducts research, the International Chair leads and supports the students and colleagues of the University in their efforts of establishing international relations and the internationally high level in their education and research.

II. General tasks of the International Chair:

Research, innovation in knowledge and education is the three essential part of NUPS’ operation. Regarding these fields the “International Chair” is responsible for:

- Education: delivering MA and PhD courses and further training programmes, providing lectures, seminars and courses in English.
- Cooperate with colleagues to enhance educational outcomes and find the best practice.
- Research: contribution to the development of education materials, involvement in the activities of research working groups, establishment of new research projects and working groups, efforts aimed at publications and academic organizing activities.

The applicant prepares a preliminary academic programme that is in line with the University’s strategy and corresponds to its aims while containing the applicants ideas on the above mentioned activities.

III. Fields of expertise:

1. Political Sciences, State and Governance
2. Public Policy, Public Administration
3. International and European Studies, Public Diplomacy
4. Law Enforcement and Policing
5. Military Sciences, Military Engineering

IV. Requirements

- The International Chair is required to be in residence at NUPS for the duration of the fellowship
- The “International Chair” will provide a mid-term and a final narrative report in English on the accomplishments achieved
- The “International Chair” is required to teach at least 6 hours/week
- The “International Chair shall summarise his/her experiences that he/she has gathered and put forward proposals concerning the possible ways of improving the “International Chair” program

V. Allowances:

- employment and gross 700,000 HUF (approx. 2220 EUR or 2420 USD) salary according to the public service rules in Hungary;
- one-time cost of international round trip between residence and Budapest;
- housing benefit;
- University services (sporting facilities, libraries, database, etc.) free of charge;
- full health insurance coverage.

VI. Criteria and conditions of application:

- full proficiency in English language;
- outstanding academic achievements in a field of science relevant to the University’s educational and research strategy;
- internationally renowned academic activity;
- engaged activity in education and academic organizing;
- membership in international academic bodies, organizations.

VII. Documents and certificates for submission:

- completed application form (available [here](#))
- professional CV with list of publications;
- preliminary annual professional programme in a field of science relevant to the University's educational and research strategy (courses, research projects, etc.);
- statement that the applicant agrees to the management of his/her provided personal data with regard to the restricted procedure.
- a letter of reference

Duration of the title and mandate: 1st of September 2016 – 31st of July 2017. One academic year that can be further extended.

The title is eligible for display: subsequent to the evaluation of applications.

Deadline of applications 15th of April 2016 /12:00 hrs GMT+1

Late and/or incomplete applications will not be considered.
